




Common Doubts About The Church

Q: What else does the Bible say about this?

"The church is full of hypocrites." Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, 10 nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God. 11 Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God.

— Ephesians 5:25–27 NAS95

A: YES! 100%

Q: Are there hypocrites outside of the church?

A: YES! 100%

- A hypocrite is someone who is pretending to be something that they are not.
- It literally meant a stageplayer, an actor.
- * A hypocrite is someone who professes one thing, yet does the opposite.

"For what I am doing, I do not understand; for I am not practicing what I would like to do, but I am doing the very thing I hate."



We should all strive by God's grace not to be hypocritical.


However, we must honestly evaluate ourselves in light of God's Word.

"But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal; for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." - Matthew 6:19-21 NAS95

"For the ministry of this service is not only fully supplying the needs of the saints, but is also overflowing through many thanksgivings to God."



Q: What does Jesus say about this?


But wishing to justify himself, he said to Jesus,

Revelation 7:9–10 NAS95


God's Church is a DIVERSE BODY from all around the world!

How can our church restore trust?

- ✦ Hebrews 12:1 Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,
- ◆ Hebrews 12:2 fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- ◆ Hebrews. 12:3 For consider Him who has endured such hostility by sinners against Himself, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.
